Eligibility requirement

Individual award nominees must be currently living in **Australia** to be eligible.

Uploads

Individual profile: Provide a short professional bio.

Supporting material: Upload or link to any supporting material relevant to this nomination.

Headshot upload: Upload a high-quality professional headshot.

Nomination Questions

Why are you a strong fit for Digital Economy Leader of the Year? Please describe your leadership role, area of influence and how your work has contributed to the advancement of Australia's digital economy. (200 words max)

What have you led, achieved or materially contributed during the awards period? Include relevant achievements such as organisational leadership, industry initiatives, innovation, business growth, policy engagement, ecosystem development, technology adoption, market development, partnerships, research, education, advocacy, governance or other major contributions. (300 words max)

What impact has your leadership had on your organisation, industry, markets or Australia's digital economy? Summarise the outcomes your leadership has helped deliver. This may include industry growth, market development, customer outcomes, policy influence, improved trust, investment, innovation, adoption, productivity, capability building, ecosystem development, organisational growth, public awareness or other measurable results. (300 words max)

How have you demonstrated vision, influence and future leadership in Australia's digital economy? Describe what makes your leadership distinctive, including your vision, integrity, influence, judgement, collaboration, industry reputation, trust-building, responsible innovation, values, strategic direction, future plans or ongoing contribution to Australia's digital economy. (200 words max)
